PIRATES IN PLYMOUTH?

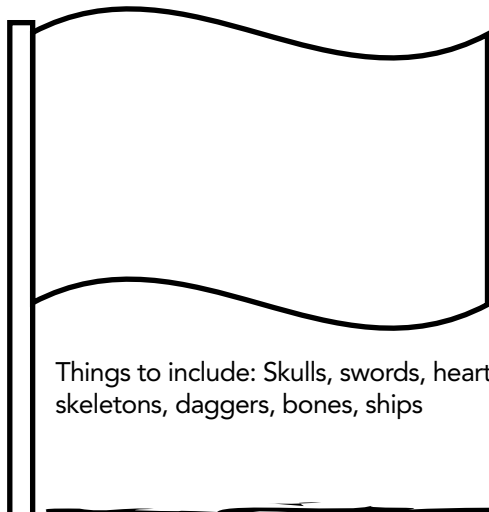

Many pirates had their very own flag patterns to fly above their ships! What would yours be?



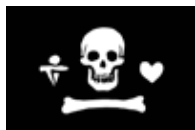
Things to include: Skulls, swords, hearts, skeletons, daggers, bones, ships



Blackbeard's Flag



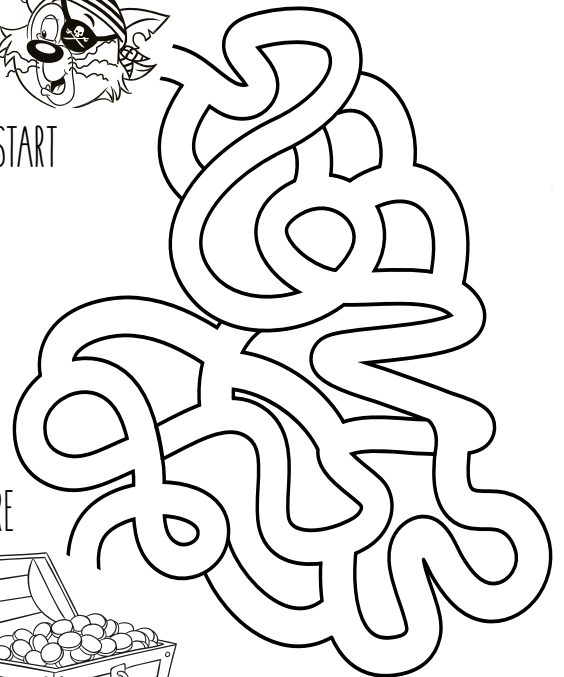
Thomas Tew's Flag



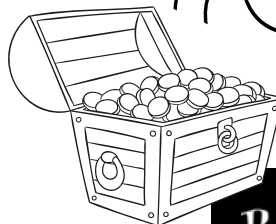
